LIMITED TICKETS ARE AVAILABLE FOR PURCHASE FROM THE TORONTO COUNCIL C14 – CNPA TO ATTEND THE BUE JAYS IN ACTION ON SUNDAY, 15 SEPTEMBER 2024.

A block of tickets have been purchased for the **September 15, 2024, Blue Jays vs St. Louis Cardinals** @ **1:35 pm at Toronto's Rogers Centre**. The tickets can only be provided electronically. There is a limit of 2 tickets per member of the Toronto Council.

The cost is \$30 per ticket and they are located as follows: Section 136L, rows 5,6,7 and Section 137R, rows 5,6,7. A portion of the cost of these tickets is subsidized by the Toronto Council.

The ticket will be available for purchase on **Thursday**, **August 15**, **2024 at 7PM**. Tickets will be on a first come first served basis and the person making the request must be a member of the Toronto Council.

The procedure for obtaining tickets is as follows:

At 7 pm call Nancy Zajacz at **906-836-2266** or **905-717-6500** to request your **2 tickets**. Nancy will advise if tickets are available. You will need to provide your PIN number and email address.

If tickets are available you will have to log onto your online or mobile banking app, select account, select INTERAC e-Transfer, enter amount (2 x \$30 = \$60) to Nancy at **nzajacz@hotmail.com**. A security question, answer is to be sent by separate email to Nancy at the same email as noted above.

Tickets will be sent to you by email once the payment has been confirmed, for you to download to your phone.

VIA pass Issue

Some passes no longer work within the new VIA reservation system. Some old passes have initials instead of full first names. VIA reservation system no longer accepts initials (November 2023)

For VIA pass holders who intend to travel, check their VIA pass and do the following:

- If the pass contains both the full first and last name of the pass holder, no action is necessary, and travel can be booked using VIA's online system.
- If the pass contains only initials, contact CN Pension & Benefits Administration (1-800-361-0739) at least 4 weeks prior to travel to have a new pass issued.
- For those who do not intend to travel on VIA, or if their pass has the full spelling of their first and last name, no action is required.

It is the member's responsibility to create an online profile with VIA, and members should contact VIA customer service for any online issues at 1-888-VIA-RAIL. (1-888-842-7245)
